



The first Summit was held in June 2008 with about 180 attendees and has grown each year. The Summits are designed to help those involved in Emergency Management to overcome misconceptions about jurisdictional boundaries, organization, tribal resources, and receiving federal assistance. It has evolved into an excellent opportunity for Tribal, Federal, State, and local officials to network with other agencies and organizations.


