

ITEMC was formed in December 2004 as learning and networking resource for Tribal Emergency Management professionals. Because of the checker-board layout of our tribal lands, the need for networking, enhancing and strengthening our working relationships with Federal, State, County and City governments soon became paramount. The first Summit was held in June 2008 with about 180 attendees and has grown each year. 
